Equine Education Scholarship - Junior

This scholarship is open to all junior WHVPHA members who have shown an interest and good sportsmanship in any aspect of the horse industry. A candidate may apply for this scholarship to help with any type of equine related activity that will educationally benefit the candidate.

The amount of the scholarship will be up to \$1,000. More than one scholarship may be awarded during the scholarship season. This award is to be used by a junior (under 18) for riding, lessons with a professional of their choice, clinics, educational seminars, betterment of the rider or any other activity that the Scholarship Committee feels qualifies.

To qualify for a scholarship a candidate must:

1. Have been a member in good standing for at least one calendar year.
2. Submit an application between the dates of **February 1 and April 30** of the current calendar year.
3. Write an essay, approximately 500 words, answering the following question: What is a challenge you have faced in your junior riding career? How did you overcome it?
4. Submit a resume of your equine experience and what the funds will be used for. Please indicate the amount requested, if necessary.
5. Provide one letter of recommendation showing how the candidate has clearly demonstrated they are an outstanding sportsman and an asset to the horse community.

A completed packet must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee no later than April 30th.
