Equine Education Scholarship - Amateur

This scholarship is open to all adult amateur WHVPHA members who have shown an interest and good sportsmanship in any aspect of the horse industry. A candidate may apply for this scholarship to help with any type of equine related activity that will educationally benefit the candidate.

The amount of the scholarship will be up to \$1,000. More than one scholarship may be awarded during the scholarship season. This award is to be used by an adult amateur (18+) for riding, lessons with a professional of their choice, clinics, educational seminars, betterment of the rider or any other activity that the Scholarship Committee feels qualifies.

To qualify for a scholarship a candidate must:

- 1. Have been a member in good standing for at least one calendar year.
- 2. Submit an application between the dates of **February 1 and April 30** of the current calendar year.
- 3. Write an essay, approximately 500 words, answering the following question: "How has your equine experience impacted your life as an adult?"
- 4. Submit a resume of your equine experience and what the funds will be used for. Please indicate the amount requested, if necessary.
- 5. Provide one letter of recommendation showing how the candidate has clearly demonstrated they are an outstanding sportsman and an asset to the horse community.

A completed packet must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee no later than April 30th.
